# SUPPORT OUR NEWS MEDIA AND CBC / RADIOCANADA A real COMMON SENSE REVOLUTION

In recent years, multinational web giants have siphoned off most of the advertising revenue on which our news outlets depended, sparking a wave of closures and layoffs, and undermining our access to information.

At a time when misinformation is spreading fast, reliable and balanced news coverage, both inside and outside the major urban centres, is essential for our democracy. Government must step in to ensure the survival of news media and safeguard citizens' right to information. Instead, the Conservatives are gunning for CBC / Radio-Canada. Our public broadcaster has played a vital social, cultural and democratic role for decades. Slashing its funding would cut off entire communities from news and culture. The next federal government must support our media with new financial and tax measures, and guarantee predictable, long-term funding for CBC / Radio-Canada.

A real COMMON SENSE REVOLUTION

Intolerance, racism and hatred have no place in our society. Unfortunately, hate speech has proliferated in recent years and its purveyors are becoming increasingly unabashed.

We must fight this trend. The next federal government must adopt an approach to immigration that is more inclusive, more respectful of the dignity of immigrants, and more consistent with a forward-looking vision for our workplaces and our society. It must address the factors that make immigrants vulnerable and their status precarious. A real common sense government must ensure that everyone working in Canada is fully protected by our labour laws, regardless of immigration status or whether they have a work permit. It must also abolish the closed work permits under the Temporary Foreign Worker Program, which tie workers to a single employer and create conditions akin to modern-day slavery. In addition to fighting hate speech against immigrants, we must combat hate speech against women, racialized people, LGBTQ+ people and Indigenous people.

## REFORM EMPLOYMENT INSURANCE A real COMMON SENSE REVOLUTION

What do atypical workers (such as part-time, seasonal and temporary workers), gig workers and the self-employed have in common? They are all ill-served by the current employment insurance system.

These predominantly young and female groups need better protection under EI. The CSN is calling for EI reform to make the system more inclusive and better suited to today's labour market realities. Among other things, the notorious "black hole," the period when seasonal workers have no income because they have exhausted their EI benefits but cannot yet return to work, must be eliminated. The federal parties must commit to improving access to EI and the duration and level of benefits. Employment insurance reform is real common sense.
